**Additional Information:** The Police department currently has 96 open case reports. The Police Department's total reports received were 24 for the month, an increase of 2 reports when compared to December 2017 in which the department received 22 reports. Offense reports received for 2018 increased by 32, with 278 reports when compared to 2017 which the department handled 246 reports. Arrest reports received for 2018 was 72 which increased by 53 reports when compared to 2017 in which the department handled 19 arrest reports for the year.
