**V. REPORT OF CITY OFFICIALS:**

**Report of Income Tax Administrator Dorothy Vance:**

Mayor Cook reported for Mrs. Vance that \$26,015.03 was collected for the month of January 2011.

### **Report of Police Chief Tim Tyree:**

Chief Tyree reported that for the month of January 2011, there were 320 calls for service. Hours worked were as followed: Chief Tyree-134 regular, 11 overtime; Officer Nolley-144 regular, 9.5 overtime; Officer Boris-156 regular, 12.5 overtime; Officer Evans- 44 regular, 0 overtime; and Officer Cheas Carter-96 regular hours. There were 2 Traffic Crash Report, and 12 Offense Reports. Arrest Information: Arrests –7, Traffic Citations – 10, and Warning Citations – 27. Police vehicle information: Unit 1 – 2005 Crown Victoria – 1,320 miles driven, Unit 2 – 1998 Chevy Lumina - 0 miles driven, Unit 3 – 2008 Crown Victoria – 1,576 miles driven. Repairs: \$127 for battery. Training: \$580.

### **Additional Information from Chief Tyree:**

The Police Department has 95 active case reports.

The departments total reports received for the month of January was 12 compared to January 2010 the department received 8 reports.

Sgt. Nolley received training in Columbus for the Reid Technique for interviewing and interrogation; the training will aid Sgt. Nolley in his new position as investigator for the department.

The 2005 Ford Explorer is now in service and has shown to be very dependable and handles great in the snow and ice, I want to thank the Mayor and Council for purchasing the vehicle. It will be a great addition to the department in order for us to continue to do our best while serving the citizens of Leesburg.

### **Report of Administrator Freddie Snyder:**

-The radio transmitter on the water tower was installed and is up and running.

-Unger Construction is to start next week installing new well and electric hook up.

-We have approximately 20-25% of our salt supply left. We have been mixing in grit to make our supply last longer.

-McCarty Engineering has surveyed the Shafer property for the easement.

Environmental Engineering is to get the appraisal on the easement.

-Met with Ohio Risk Management, went over several safety matters and laws – they gave us a good report.

-Met with Frank Leone from Environmental Engineering telling him the Phil Weyrich will take over as plant operator as of 3/1/11. However, we still need to find someone to fill in when Phil is gone.

### **Report of Fiscal Officer Tracy Evans:**

-Requested Income Tax refund of \$3.84.
