

ORDINANCE NO. 05-04

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING POLICY FOR SWIMMING POOL FILLS
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LEESBURG AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish policy for swimming pool fills with the
Village of Leesburg,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Leesburg, Highland County, Ohio that:

SECTION ONE: the following shall be and is hereby adopted as the
policy for swimming pool fills within the Village of Leesburg.

- a. There will be a once a year only sewer deduction for swimming pool
fills made during the same calendar year.
- b. Pools must hold a minimum of 1,000 gallons of water.
- c. The resident (pool owner) shall pay the total cost for the potable water
used. Only the portion of the water and sewer bill relating to sewer
charges will be adjusted.
- d. The resident should contact the Village of Leesburg to request said
adjust. All sewer deductions will be made based on the average billing
for the past six (6) months.

SECTION TWO: That this ordinance shall be declared an emergency
necessary for the welfare of the Village of Leesburg and shall take effect and be
in force on and after its passage.
