

ORDINANCE NO. 09-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TERMINATION OF WATER SERVICE IN THE EVENT OF EXTRAORDINARY USE

Be it ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Leesburg, State of Ohio, that

SECTION ONE:

The Village Administrator shall shut-off water service to any customer who is found to have used in excess of 8,000 gallons more than water the average monthly water usage for that customer, unless prior written notice by the customer has been given to the Village Utilities Department that water usage may exceed this amount. In the event of a shut-off under this section, notice of that fact shall be attempted personally on the customer, left at the service address or by mail to the service address of record customer, of the Village action and the possibility of a leak. Water connection will not be restored until the Village Administrator verifies the leak has been repaired. Restoration of service without discovery of a leak shall require full payment of all outstanding Village utilities bills and result in denials for any requests for credits due to leaks on the water or sewer bills for that customer. There shall be no disconnect or reconnect fee charged for Village-initiated action under this provision.

SECTION TWO:

This ORDINANCE shall become effective upon passage by a majority of Council, approval by the Mayor and after 30-days following publication.
