Additional Information: The Police Department currently has 72 active case reports.

The Police Department's total reports received were 17 for the month , a decrease of 8 when compared to December 2010 in which the department received 25 reports. Total reports for 2011 were 257, a decrease of 1 when compared to 2010 in which the department received 258 reports. The department total calls for service for 2011 were 3,988 which showed an increase of 384 over 2010 total of 3,604.

The departments Kenwood Radio Repeater had to be repaired and will have to be replaced in 2012 due to new regulations from the FCC requiring narrow-band emissions. The compliance requirement date is January 1, 2013. The current repeater is too old to meet this requirement and will have to be replaced as soon as possible so the department can switch over at the same time the Highland County Sheriff's Office switches their system or the departments hand held radios will not function as well and be able to reach HCSO dispatch.

I have requested a quote from B & C Communications on the replacement of the repeater along with moving it to the Water Tower across from where the current Repeater is located. I will also be contacting Levo Communications for a second quote.
